Is There a Law That Requires Most Americans to Pay Income Tax?

<u>That's</u> the question Dr. Ward Dean has been <u>asking the IRS</u> for nearly ten years!

However, instead of <u>answering</u> his questions, Dr. Dean was <u>arrested at</u> <u>gunpoint</u> on March 17th, 2005, by a multi-jurisdictional force of IRS Special Agents, Escambia County Sheriff's deputies, and Florida State Troopers.

Dr. Dean was on his way home from the federal courthouse in Pensacola, after attempting to testify before a federal Grand Jury (he had *requested to appear*). Dr. Dean

was not allowed to present any evidence and was cut off in mid-sentence, after less than ten minutes. (The government <u>could</u>, of course, have arrested him *in the court house*, where he had been surrounded by U.S. Marshals and IRS Special Agents)

Dr. Dean has been charged with six counts of tax evasion (1997-2002)-a felony, punishable by 5 years in prison, and a \$300,000 fine (for each count).

Can the government answer the question: What law makes Dr. Dean liable for the income tax? **Will** they answer the question? And if not, **Why Not**?
